BUDAPEST RHAPSODY

The revival of polo in Hungary was highlighted by the outstandingly successful La Estancia Polo Open Budapest

Before the war, Hungary was well-known as a centre of European polo – indeed, in 1936 a Hungarian squad took part in the last Olympic Games to feature polo, in Berlin.

In early May, the largest polo event in Hungary since 1945 took place – La Estancia Polo Open Budapest. Hosted by the owners of La Estancia, Uwe and Kristina Zimmermann, who have led the Hungarian polo renaissance, four international teams competed for trophies donated by Herend, the celebrated porcelain company.
